

## Unique Disability Identity Card (UDID)

### **1. What is UDID Card?**

UDID is an integrated system for Issuance of Universal ID & Disability Certificates for Person with Disabilities with their identification and disability details.

### **2. Who can register for UDID Card?**

- i. Persons with Disabilities who already have a Disability Certificate.
- ii. Persons with Disabilities who do not have any Disability Certificate.
- iii. Persons with Disabilities who have applied for Disability Certificates and their Certificates are under process.
- iv. Persons with Disabilities whose certificates are temporary and are in need of re-assessment.
- v. Persons with Disabilities whose applications were rejected/want to re-apply for Disability Certificates and also for re-assessment of percentage.

### **3. What is the process for registration in UDID?**

Registration can be done through ONLINE mode by clicking the Register link in the web-page i.e. [www.swavlambancard.gov.in](http://www.swavlambancard.gov.in).

### **4. Does existing PwD certificate holder need to register in UDID?**

Yes, all existing PwD certificate holders are required to register in UDID.

### **5. What are the benefits in registering through UDID?**

- i. UDID card will capture all the necessary details like identity, disability details which can be decoded with the help of e-reader. There is no need to make multiple copies of documents, maintain and carry multiple documents by Persons with Disabilities.
- ii. UDID card will be treated as proof for Persons with Disabilities all over India.
- iii. UDID card will be the single document of identification, verification of the identity of disability for availing various benefits by Government in future.
- iv. UDID Card will also help in streamlining and tracking of the physical and financial progress of beneficiary at all levels.

**6. How will one know that she/he has successfully registered in UDID?**

All the beneficiaries who have registered in UDID will receive one confirmation message to their registered mobile number after successful registration with their acknowledgement number for time to time correspondence.

**7. Where will the UDID card be delivered?**

UDID card will be delivered to the beneficiaries at the address mentioned by them during online registration by post.

**8. What is the role of Chief Medical Officer (CMO)?**

CMO will be the issuing authority for issuing the UDID Card. He/ She will be the final decision maker in issuing / Rejecting the UDID Card. His/ Her signature will be present on the UDID Card.

## **STEPS TO BE CARRIED OUT FOR PROCESSING UDID CARD**

### **STEP 1: REGISTRATION**

Registration can be done by PwDs through online mode via [www.swavlambancard.gov.in](http://www.swavlambancard.gov.in) portal.

#### **Documents required during registration process**

➤ **Personal Details**

- Scanned Copy of Passport size photo of format jpeg/jpg/gif/ png of size [15KB-30KB]
- Scanned Copy of Signature /thumb impression of format jpeg/jpg/gif/ png of size [3KB-30KB]

➤ **Address Proof Scanned Copy (of format jpeg/jpg/gif/ png/pdf of size [10KB-100KB])**

- Scanned Copy of Aadhar Card / Driving License or Passport/Ration Card /Voter Id / Other (Domicile Certificate)

**Note: The entered Address proof should match with the uploaded copy of the Address proof.**

➤ **Person already having valid disability certificate**

- Person already having valid disability certificate should upload the scanned copy of all the pages of disability certificate (of format jpeg/jpg/gif/ png/pdf of size [10KB-100KB])

➤ **Identity Details**

- Scanned Copy of Aadhar Card /Driving License /Pan Card /Ration Card / Voter ID

➤ **Tracking Status of the UDID Card:**

The PwDs candidate should download their application and maintain the same for the further steps. The PwDs candidates will receive updates through registered Mobile Number and email id.
